

Sutaarutit

Getting tools and materials to make work can be one the first challenges artists face to creating new pieces. Sutaarutit builds on the IAF's existing partnership with the [Ontario Arts Council's Indigenous Visual Artists' Materials](#) grant and provides opportunities for artists to fund these purchases. Grants of **\$500** or **\$1,000** are available and emerging artists are strongly encouraged to apply.

Eligibility

- Must be Inuk and living in Canada with citizenship, permanent residence or refugee status;
- Must live outside of Ontario;
 - » *Tip: If you are an Inuit visual artist living in Ontario, you have the same opportunity to apply to the Ontario Arts Council's [Indigenous Visual Artists' Materials Grant](#) instead.*
- Must be a visual artist;
- Be at least 18 years old;
- Have specialized training in their artistic discipline (academic accreditation not a requirement);
- Recognized as an artist by their peers (i.e. artists working in the same artistic tradition) for a minimum of 1 year; and
- Are committed to continually furthering their artistic practice.
