

Kajungiqsaut Grants Terms and Conditions

If you are successful in your Kajungiqsaut grant application, , and choose to accept the funding, you understand and agree that the following terms and conditions apply:

Multiple Grant Eligibility

Recipients may receive one grant from Sutaarutit, Iniqarvik, or Turaagaq, and because we have multiple deadlines for Sutaarutit, everyone can also receive one additional Sutaarutit grant within our program cycle (typically September through March) for a maximum of two grants per program cycle. If you apply for two Sutaarutit grants, they must be for different deadlines and different expenses.

If you received a Kajungiqsaut grant in the previous cycle and have not yet completed and reported on your project you can still apply for a new grant in the current cycle even if the deadline comes before you expect to finish your earlier project. However, if you are approved for a grant in this cycle, any new funding will be held until all final reports from the previous program cycle are received.

Acceptance of Grant Funds

Grant recipients must acknowledge and accept their grant payment within 3 months of receiving notification that their application was successful, otherwise funds will be considered forfeit and will be re-distributed to other applicants.

Unclaimed Grant Funds

The Inuit Art Foundation will make every effort to ensure you receive your funding and will communicate with you initially via email. If we are unable to reach you by email, we will attempt other means and will make multiple attempts. However, even in the case where funds are initially accepted, but we are unable to distribute funds due to limited or unreliable communication, the funds will eventually be considered forfeit and will be re-distributed to other applicants.

Purpose and Use of Grant Funds

Kajungiqsaut Grant funds can only be used for the project submitted in the application and only by the applicant/s listed in the application. Fraudulent Applications

The IAF does not condone applications that are submitted under fraudulent circumstances including, but not limited to submitting artwork that is not your own, applying under a false name, knowingly submitting incorrect information in your application, such as confirmed collaborators or budget items, and falsely

identifying as Inuit. Applications that contain fraudulent information will be disqualified or funding may be withdrawn if already awarded.

Grants are Taxable Income

The IAF will issue all grant recipients a T4A for their funds, which should be retained for income tax purposes. To accept and receive your grant and in order to issue your T4A, you are required to fill out this [secure online form](#), which is also provided in your grant notification email, to submit your Social Insurance Number (SIN) or GST registration number (if you operate as a registered business). Reporting Requirements

Successful applicants will be sent a [Final Report Form](#) and reminder when you are nearing the end of the timeline indicated in your application to summarize your project, how you used the funds, as well as an option to anonymously share how you think IAF can make improvements to the program. Alternatively, you can also speak directly with the IAF Program Officer to discuss changes to your project, complete your final report verbally, and/or provide your feedback. There is no time limit to finishing your project, however, a final report must be submitted within 3 months of completing your project. In order to receive further Kajungisaut grant funds, a final report for this project must be submitted.
